

What is the Oklahoma County Juvenile Bureau?

The Oklahoma County Juvenile Bureau (OCJB) directly facilitates the efforts of the court by providing necessary support and follow-through services required by law. The Chief Administrative Officer of the Bureau is the Director who is charged by the Administrative Judge of the Juvenile Division with the organization, development, and management of the administration/personnel, investigative, social, and financial work for the Bureau and Detention Center.

The Bureau is responsible for receiving, evaluating and determining appropriate action pertaining to persons under the age of eighteen (18) years found within Oklahoma County and alleged to be delinquent or in need of supervision. Additionally, the Bureau carries out orders of the Juvenile Division of the District Court and serves all process regarding Juvenile matters.

Court Services

There are two major units within Court Services—Intake and Diversion Services and Probation. Intake and Diversion Services is often the first contact that a juvenile has with the Juvenile Justice System after the police department. The Intake Unit's main duties include preliminary inquiries on referrals, screening detention admissions, and deferred filings. The Probation Unit of the OCJB is mandated to provide probation services to juveniles of Oklahoma County by State Statutes. Probation is a court service that provides the community with protection and accountability of the juvenile, and promotes competency and rehabilitation of the juvenile.

Detention Center

The Oklahoma County Juvenile Detention Facility is an 80-bed, 30,000 square foot, maximum security facility designed for short-term secure placement of Juveniles in Oklahoma County. The Facility is licensed by the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) and is subject to the rules and regulations as established by that State Agency. It is the largest licensed juvenile detention facility in the State. Regular audits conducted by the State, American Correctional Association (ACA), and other applicable regulatory agencies have proven the quality of care and level of accountability of the Facility and staff far exceed the minimum requirements.


The Facility and staff serve the citizens of Oklahoma County 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

Juveniles detained in the Detention Center are provided the opportunity to participate in a

variety of programs. All programs foster the Oklahoma County Juvenile Bureau and Detention Center's mission statement providing opportunities for success and personal progress.

The Juveniles are provided educational opportunities daily, including instruction through OKC Public School-Alternative Education program. Three meals a day are prepared by qualified food service staff and meals are served in the dining room. Medical staff is on site and medical services are available for the Juveniles 7 days a week.

OCJB Detention Officers supervise and are responsible for the security and safety of the Juvenile Residents.
