## Life Skills/Survival Skills for Young Men & Women

These programs consist of two evening classes per week for six weeks and a different topic and speaker are presented each class for a total of 12 topics in all.

To qualify for the program, the juvenile must be between the age of fourteen and seventeen.

Cost of the program for all referred is \$25. Under special circumstances, one may request a scholarship, which must be approved and given only once.

Juvenile must attend all 12 classes to graduate from program and are required to do an initial assessment with the facilitator, at which time they will decide the entry and exit date. When the program is completed and fee paid a certificate will be given to participant.


## GED Classes



The Juvenile Bureau offers Free **GED** classes provided by Youth Cornerstone (funded by Office of Juvenile Affairs) on Tuesdays and Thursdays from. This is a self-paced curriculum that also assist with tutoring if needed. This program will also pay for **GED** test upon completion of all classes. ### ANGER MANAGEMENT

### CYCLE OF CHANGE PREVENTION PROGRAM

This free 3 hour program is offered one Saturday every other month, for ages 7 to 14.
